


Population Projection Project



How can we know whether more families are moving in to our communities than are moving out? What about young adults and retirees? What if trends in migration, mortality, and fertility continue into the future?

These questions are important when considering Official Community Plans, demands on water works, roads, as well as opening and closing of public, and private facilities.

The Population Projection Project uses an easy to understand, widely accepted method, referring to open, readily available census counts to create verifiable reproducible population projections.



The resulting projections have both internal and 'face' validity and are transparent and easy to explain to a wide range of audiences.

Examining population change allows us to have a better understanding of the challenges and opportunities facing our Regions, Municipalities and Communities.
