Dear Mr Munroe,

The Queen has asked me to thank you for your letter of 31st August, and Her Majesty hopes you will understand that, because of the enormous number of letters and messages she has received in the last few months, it has not been possible to reply to you until now.

While careful note has been taken of the issue relating to your employment, I should explain that this is not a matter in which The Queen would intervene. As a constitutional Sovereign, Her Majesty acts through her personal representative, the Governor General, on the advice of her Canadian Ministers and, therefore, you were quite correct to address your appeal in the first instance to the relevant Canadian authorities.
