At the end of June 2017, at the International Conference of Population Geographies, I presented the findings comparing the 2016 population projections (calculated directly from the 1996 to 2011 Censuses of Population) to the actual 2016 Census of Population counts for Canada, BC, the Nanaimo RD and the Parksville Census Agglomeration (Oceanside). The findings included comparisons of the total population for these areas as well as comparisons of the number of people by age groups.

Will you please put forward a motion in the BC Legislature that public facility reviews require that more than one possible future population projection scenario (high medium low), accompanied with correct methods and data?

Given the importance of integrity - providing correct methods and data rather than providing incorrect methods and data, will you also put forward a motion assigning clear accountabilities to ensure the integrity of the population projection scenarios?
